Last week we began planning our learning for Term 2. We are excited to get started with the following topics:

Social Studies

Literacy

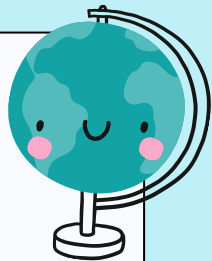
In January, we will begin the term by looking at poetry and Scots language. P6s will be writing limericks and 'octopoems' while P7s will focus on using similes and personification within poetry.

The whole class will be using note taking skills to write an explanation text linked to another curricular area. This will be combined with listening for information, paraphrasing and summarising skills. Later in the term, P6s will be learning to write a discursive text and P7s will be writing biography texts.

For reading, we will continue to look at literal, inferential and evaluative questions in response to short passages and novels.
