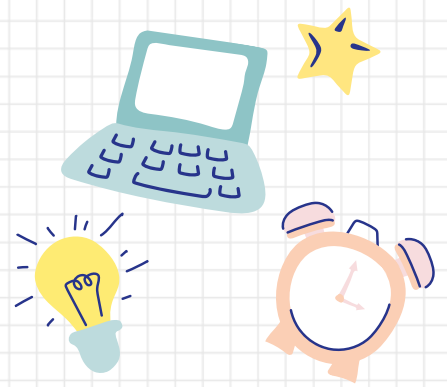




P3/4/5 NEWSLETTER

Hello families and welcome back to school for Term 1 of our new school year!
We have lots of exciting work already underway, and much more still to come.
Read on to find out a little more about what we will be covering this term.

Literacy

- We began the term by enjoying the wordless picture book Journey by Aaron Becker. Ask us more about this book.
- We have started our spelling and reading programme. Reading books will come home this week.
- P3's are learning to use a variety of new comprehension and grammar resources alongside activities they are familiar with.
- We will be focussing on recounts and imaginative writing this term.

Numeracy & Maths

- In numeracy we have started with some revision of previous concepts. We are taking care with the layout and presentation of our work.
- We will work on our addition, subtraction, multiplication and division skills.
- Mental maths happens daily, and we will begin with a focus on the language of maths.
- In maths we will develop our measure and money skills this term.

Social Studies

- Our Enquiry Based Learning topic this term is the Romans.
- We are currently working together to establish our areas of enquiry and finalise our group research questions.
- We will develop note-taking and research skills using books, the internet and other sources.
- Lots of cross curricular links will be made in all areas of our learning this term.

Health & Wellbeing

- In P.E. this term we will develop and progress skills in tennis, cycling and dance amongst other activities.
- P3 will learn about emotions, actions and behaviours, and to recognise personal strengths.
- P4/5 will learn about positive friendships, and will learn how to build on their strengths and abilities.
